Grilling Safety Tips

Firing up the grill, cooking hot dogs and burgers are a welcomed sight at a family cookout. But a fire anywhere else can make your summer kick-off barbecue memorable for all the wrong reasons. Below are some tips for you to remember when you are having a great day in the sun.

Safety Tips:

- Propane and charcoal grills should only be used outdoors.
- Grills should be placed away from the home, deck railing, and away from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Keep kids and pets away from the grilling area.
- Keep the grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grill and in the trays below it.
- Never leave the grill unattended.

Charcoal Grills: There are several ways to get a charcoal grill ready. Chimney starters allow you to start the charcoal using newspaper as a fuel. You can also use starter fluid. Please only use charcoal starter fluid, never add more starter fluid or any other flammable liquids to the fire. Another starter you can use is an electric starter, just be sure to use an outdoor extension cord. When you are finished using a charcoal grill, be sure to let the coals cool completely before disposing them in a metal container.

Propane Grills: Check the gas tank hose for leaks before using it for the first time each year. You can apply a light soapy water solution to the hose. A propane leak will release bubbles. If the grill has a gas leak by smell or the test above and there is no flame, turn off the gas tank and grill. If it stops, get the grill serviced before using again. If you smell gas while cooking, get away from the grill and call the fire department. Do not move the grill.
