
## We Will Miss You Beth & Brittany

We get the question “Is seepage covered on my home-owners policy” quite often. We would like to give you the 411 on what is covered and what is not.

**Water Backup coverage** is when your storm sewer or sanitary sewer backs up into your home. This usually comes in through the sump well. Sump pump failures can occur because of power outages or motor failures. Water Backup coverage is an added endorsement on your homeowner's or business insurance policies.

**Seepage** is any water that comes through cracks in the foundations and generally cannot be insured. Seepage is excluded from your homeowner's policy.
